Urban Research University Transition





Scholarly Indexed Publications - Web of Science







College of Graduate Studies Theses and Dissertations Completed



Scholarly Indexed Publications - Web of Science






IRB Research Distributions



Funding to Support Research




Youngstown State University Total Fiscal Year Funding



Quality Academic Programs







Youngstown State University Total Fall Faculty FTE*




Youngstown State University **Total Student FTEs**
