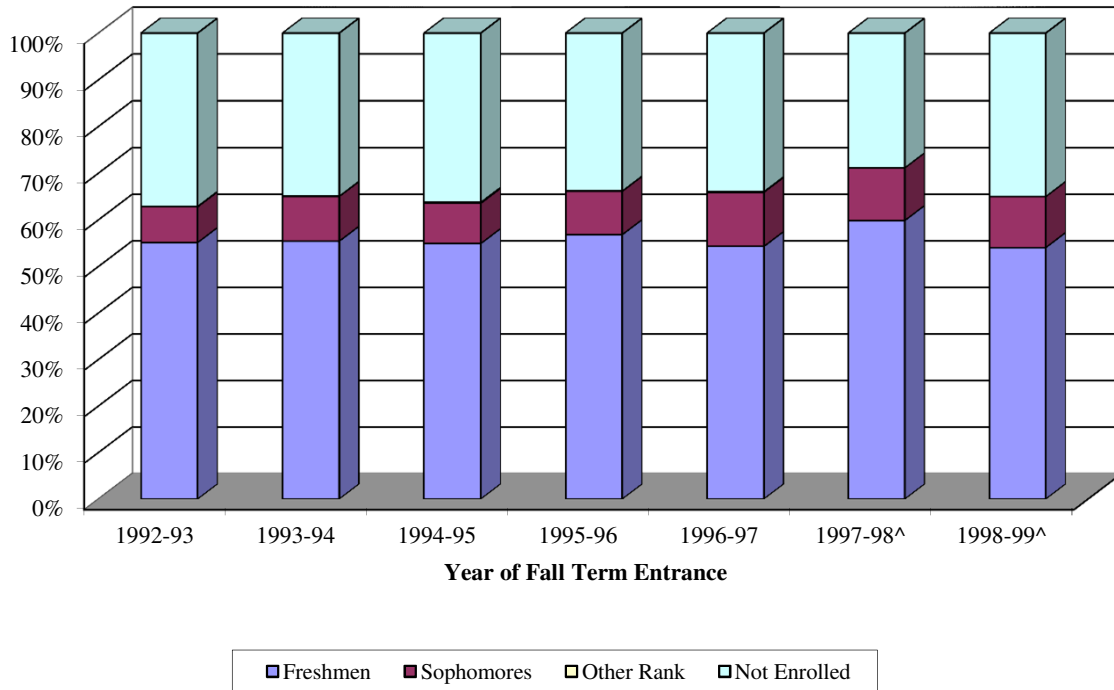


## Youngstown State University First-Time Freshmen\* One Year Later
