## Office of Human Resources Update February, 2017

## Talent Aquisition, Processing and Employee Records:

Jennifer Lewis, Director, Talent Acquisition, Processing and Employee Records and her staff members have collaborated with HRIS to facilitate the electronic hiring process noted below.

## **HRIS:**

Alisha Yanniello, Manager, HRIS has worked on moving the Classified and FOP evaluations to an electronic process. Additionally, she has done the preliminary work to facilitate electronic hiring for Part-time and Full-time Faculty and provided support to Payroll in assisting with 1095C. She is also working with Compensation and Benefits to facilitate the HAS (for the high deductible plan) and the implementation of compensation software.

### **Benefits:**

Marcie Patton, Manager, Compensation and Benefits has worked to implement A High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) option is being initiated for employees who qualify under ACA for coverage and on a voluntary basis for professional/administrative staff.

Classification and Compensation – Jennifer Gavalier, Classification and Equal Opportunity Officer has been working on the development of a YSU classified class plan.

Wellness – Carrie Clyde continues to develop and offer a variety of wellness initiatives.

## **Training & Development:**

Rosalyn Donaldson, Manager, Training & Development has been engaged in training for a variety of matters.

The search for a Training Coordinator has been finalized and the candidate is currently assessing an offer.

## **Labor Relations:**

Al Boggs, Director of Labor Relations has utilized FMCS mediation, to resolve 75 older outstanding grievances covering a variety of issues over the course of the last five months. Additionally, he has collaborated with other HR staff members and has met with ACE leadership to discuss numerous positions for appropriate inclusion or exclusion for bargaining unit placement. An agreement has been reached on voluntary inclusion or exclusion of certain positions with the union. An uncertain number of positions placed or not placed in the unit will be appealed by either side to SERB for final determination.

Al is currently serving as the university lead negotiator in the OEA/YSU contract negotiations.
