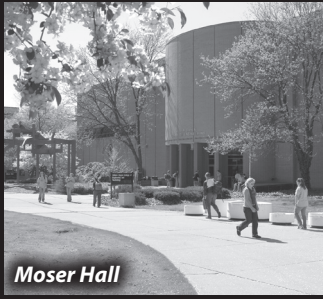

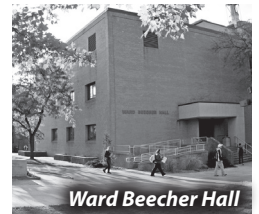

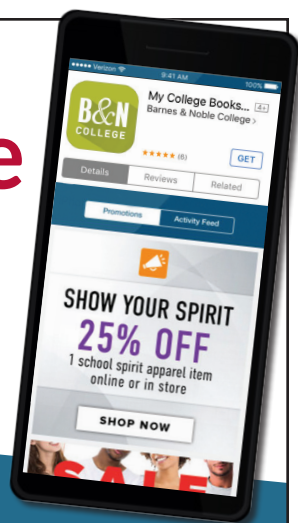

Interested in starting to earn college credit while in high school? Sign up with your school counselor **by April 1!**

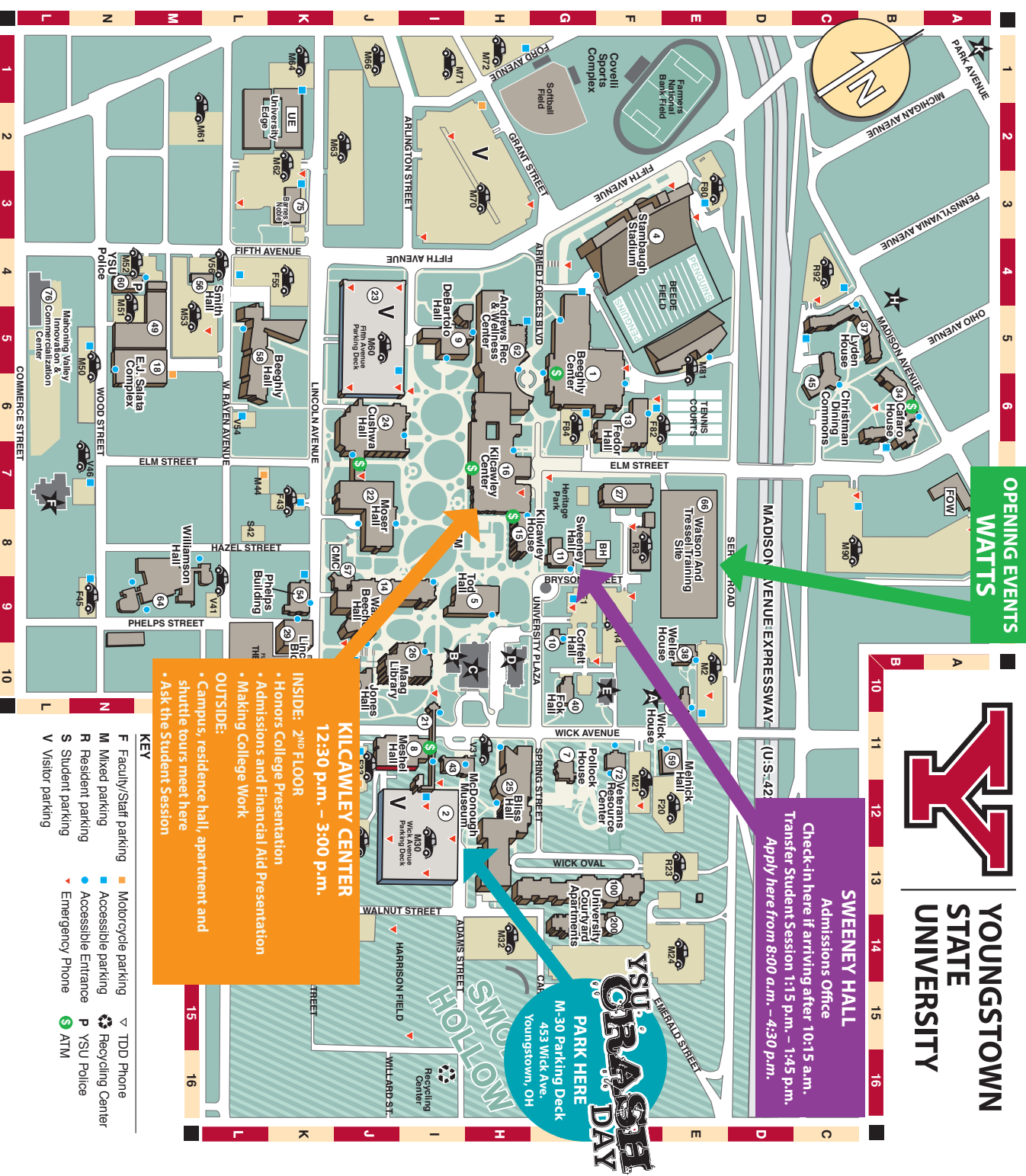
