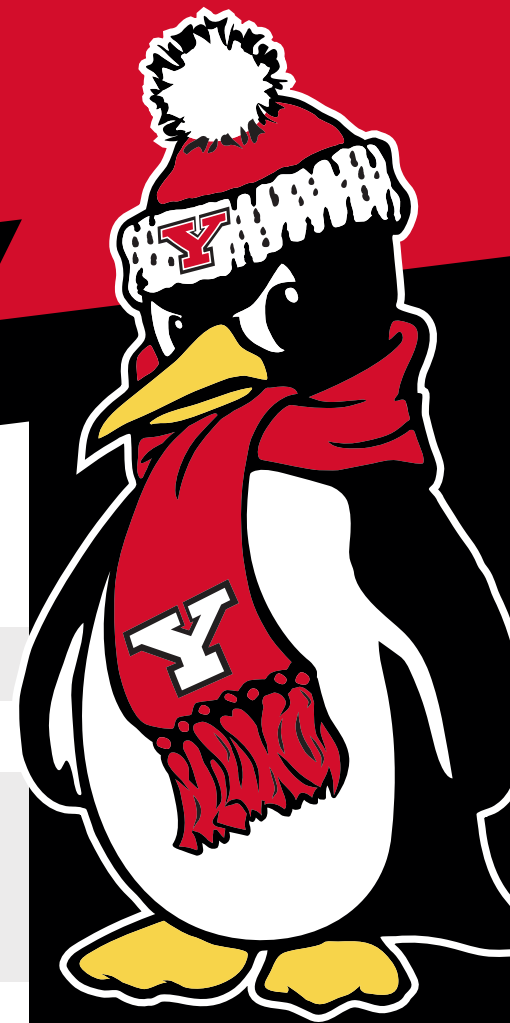

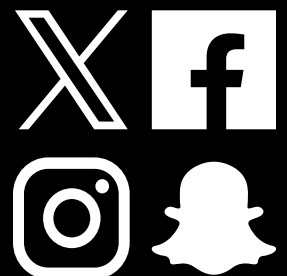

Foreign Languages Science

College Credit Plus (CCP) is a dual enrollment program for 7th–12th graders. Students earn college credit while taking classes at their high school, online or on campus. CCP may shorten the time it takes to earn a degree and provides a significant savings on future tuition.

*This program is **NO COST** to most students!*

Beginning Summer 2025, students are eligible to apply if they meet one of the following:

- **Test Optional:** Have an overall, unweighted HS GPA of 3.0 and a core GPA of 2.0
- **Test Required:** Have an overall, unweighted HS GPA of 2.0 and a core GPA of 2.0 and meet a college readiness benchmark on the ACT, SAT or Accuplacer test.
- **CCP Transfer Student:** Have a college GPA of 2.0 from another college, plus an overall, unweighted HS GPA of 2.75 and core GPA of 2.0.

Note: Admission to CCP does not guarantee enrollment in any college course. Students meet course placement requirements through ACT/SAT or university placement exams.

Interested in starting to earn college credit while in high school? Sign up with your school counselor **by April 1!**

Application Days take place between January and April at your school. You can also apply online at our website.
