


This year marks the 55th anniversary of the Youngstown State University Counseling Program. In the late 1960's, Dr. Larry DiRusso was asked to develop a counseling master's degree program - focusing on training Guidance (School) Counselors. On October 3rd, 1968 the first students at YSU attended courses in Fedor Hall pursuing their master's degree in school counseling. The program

was originally under the Department of Foundations of Education and became it's own department in 1971. In the fall of 1984, the department name was changed to Counseling to reflect the addition of a community counseling track and the new Ohio licensure for counselors. In 2006, the Department of Counseling merged with the Special Education program to provide further opportunities for program area development. A School Psychology program was added in 2011 and then, in 2017, the Educational Administration and Leadership programs were merged with Counseling and School Psychology to form the Department of Counseling, School Psychology, and Educational Leadership. Finally, in 2020, the Department of Psychology was merged with the Counseling Program to form the current Department of Psychological Sciences and Counseling.

Over the past 55 years , the YSU counseling program has a reputation for excellence. We were the first in Ohio to be accredited by The Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) achieving that distinction on October 31st, 1984. YSU currently holds CACREP accreditation through 2031. YSU is also home to the ETA Chapter of Chi Sigma Iota (CSI) which was chartered in 1985, as the 2nd Counseling Honor Society in Ohio.

In 1985, the counseling program was recognized by the Ohio Association for Counseling and Development (now the Ohio Counseling Association) with the award for the Outstanding Program in Counselor Education. In 1988, the program received a Certificate of Special Congressional Recognition by the 17th District of Ohio in recognition of the 20th anniversary. The North Central Association for Counselor Education and Supervision (NCACES) awarded the YSU Counseling Program with the Innovative Program Award in 2014 and the Association for Counselor Education and Supervision (ACES) recognized the YSU counseling program in both 2003 and 2015 with the Robert Frank Outstanding Counselor Education Program Award. This national award recognizes the nation's top counselor education program. Faculty members have received awards recognizing their scholarship and service and have been elected as leaders of counseling organizations (Chi Sigma Iota-International, Association for Humanistic Counseling, Ohio Counseling Association, Ohio Association for Counselor Education and Supervision), chartered new counseling associations (East Ohio Counseling Association), and received appointment by the Governor of Ohio to serve at the state level (Counselor, Social Worker, and Marriage & Family Therapist Board).

The counseling program has graduated 2,188 masters degree professionals (as of Fall 2023) since beginning in 1968. Alumni serve as leaders in counseling agencies, schools and universities in Northeast Ohio, Western Pennsylvania, and across the nation. Faculty are committed to developing our students as practitioners and researchers. Several outstanding alumni pursue doctoral study and are accomplished counselor educators and doctoral students. As alumni retire from careers, the 55th anniversary is an appropriate time to look back at our history and consider possibilities for our future.

Counseling Faculty

The YSU Counseling Program has the following full-time Counseling Faculty: Dr. Jake Protivnak, Counseling Program Director; Dr. Victoria Kress, Professor, Addiction Counseling / Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program Coordinator, & Community Counseling Clinic Director; Dr. Emily Herman McMillan, Professor & School Counseling Program Coordinator; Dr. Kristin Burns, Professor & College Counseling & Student Affairs Program Coordinator; and Dr. Kenneth Miller, Professor.

Part-time faculty have contributed significantly to the counseling program. They bring their counseling experiences from the day into the classroom in the evening. Our program has utilized nearly 250 different part-time faculty during the past 55 years. Many part-time faculty taught as doctoral students and continued on to careers as counselor educators.

The counseling program developed an internship program for counselor education doctoral students to provide an experience engaging in faculty duties such as teaching counseling courses, engaging in university service, attending program faculty meetings and collaborating on research. Counseling Program

Beginnings

CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING ADDICTION COUNSELING

In the 1970s, the behavioral health field began to open for masters level prepared counselors who specialized in community mental health. This was reflected by the first counselor licensure being established in Virginia in 1976 and the formation of the National Board of Certified Counselors (NBCC) and CACREP. The YSU Counseling Program offered its first counseling course designed for community counselors in 1976. In the mid 1970s and early 1980s, a group of counselors began to advocate for licensure law in Ohio. Although Larry DiRusso (YSU) already held licensure as a psychologist, he was a strong advocate for counselor licensure law in Ohio. Dr. DiRusso recognized the opportunity and the need for community counselors. Community Counseling became an official program track at YSU in 1983. Licensure for counselors in Ohio was established in 1984 and YSU was positioned to train community counselors for the Mahoning Valley. The YSU Counseling Program has been actively involved in the counseling profession at the state level and served in leadership. Dr. DiRusso was an early President of OACES in 1974-75 and was instrumental in founding the East Ohio Counselors Association (EOCA) along with Dr. Chris Faiver. Dr. Jan Gill-Wigal served as President of the Ohio Counseling Association (OCA) in 1990-91, followed by Dr. Jake Protivnak in 2009-2010, and Dr. Victoria Kress in 2014-2015. Counseling faculty, such as Dr. Victoria Kress, have influenced state counselor law through their service as Governor appointed board members on the Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, & Marriage and Family Therapist Board. In 2010, the Community Counseling track was renamed Clinical Mental Health Counseling and a new counseling program track was established for individuals interested in Addiction Counseling.

SCHOOL COUNSELING

Guidance (School) counseling was the first program track to be offered by YSU in 1968. During the past 50 years, the school counseling profession has developed from "guidance counselors" to "school counselors." The training and expected knowledge and skills of school counselors have changed and the YSU Counseling Program has changed with the times. In 1957, an individual could become a school counselor with approximately 20 hours of graduate credit. If the school counseling student had related undergraduate coursework, it appeared possible to obtain a school counselor certificate with only 12 hours of graduate credit. At the inception of the school counseling profession, the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) required coursework in guidance principles, group procedures, human growth and development, diagnostic procedures, testing & statistics , counseling principles, and educational and occupational information. In 1968, the YSU School Counseling program offered 21 quarter credit hours of guidance related school counseling coursework.

In the early 2000s, the American School Counselor Association (ASCA) created a National Model which provides a framework for school counselors to construct accountable comprehensive school counseling programs that produce measurable results in the academic, career, and personal/social issues of students. The YSU Counseling Program revised coursework to train students to develop school counseling programs consistent with the ASCA National Model in Ohio. Counselor educators in Ohio believed that the school counseling profession was leaving out strong candidates and that teaching and school counseling should have separate identities. Counselor educators throughout the state, including former faculty member Dr. Don Martin, advocated for this change. The YSU faculty supported this change and testified at the state level. After much debate, the Ohio Department of Education changed the school counseling licensure law in 2003 and opened up the profession to individuals with backgrounds other than teacher education. In the summer of 2023, the YSU School Counseling track increased to 60 hours of required graduate credit. The YSU School Counseling program has developed into a program with an urban training focus. The majority of our school counselors complete their school counseling internship in an urban school district (e.g., Youngstown City Schools). The School Counseling program has a grant that establishes Graduate Assistant school counseling students working a minimum of 20 hours per week in Youngstown City schools for the duration of their graduate program (e.g., approx. 2 years). This provides these students with hours of school counseling experience from the beginning to the completion of their program- more hours counseling experience as a student

COLLEGE COUNSELING & STUDENT AFFAIRS

Youngstown State University is the only CACREP-accredited College Counseling & Student Affairs programs in Ohio. The first student affairs course at YSU was offered in 1978. In 1983, the Higher Education Student Services track was formalized as a specialty. In addition to taking the core counseling courses, the subspecialty allowed students to select from courses such as Student Personnel Programs in Higher Education, Issues in College Student Personnel Work, Group Procedures in Counseling, Field Studies in Higher Education Student Services, and Occupational and Educational Information in Guidance. An additional 9 to 15 hours were also taken from Foundations, Education, Psychology, Sociology, and Philosophy. Internship opportunities were available primarily at Thiel College and at Youngstown State University. In 1984, the Higher Education counseling track received initial accreditation from CACREP. In 1986, Jeff Fahey, a counseling student in the higher education program track, won the Ohio College Personal Association (OCPA) Presidents Discretionary Award. This award recognized him for contributing greatly to the growth of the organization. Under the direction of Deborah Jackson in 2005, the Student Affairs Leadership and Practice program expanded from a 36 hour to 48 hour program. In 2010, the program track name was changed to Student Affairs and College Counseling to align with CACREP and provide students with the option of licensure or non-licensure track depending upon their functional areas of interest in which they complete their internship. In 2019, the name of the program changed to College Counseling & Student Affairs and then increased to a 60 semester hour program in the summer of 2023.



STUDENT AFFAIRS STUDENT ORGANIZATION (SALSA)

The College Counseling & Student Affairs program recognized the need to form a group that addressed the interest of students in a higher education track. In 2003, with the support of Dr. Jan Gill Wigal and Dr. Marty Manning as the advisors, higher education students, Tysa Egerton, Ben Blanco, & Kellie Denmeade, formed the student group named Preprofessional Association for Student Services (PASS). CHI SIGMA IOTA ETA CHAPTER

Chi Sigma Iota (CSI), the international honor society has played an important role in the development of counseling students since 1985. Chi Sigma Iota was founded at Ohio University in 1985 by Dr. Tom Sweeney. It was formed to recognize outstanding achievement by students and professionals within the counseling profession. YSU counseling program and students followed the lead of Ohio University and founded a chapter of CSI under the leadership of Jan Gill-Wigal. On September 9, 1985, YSU became the second CSI chapter in the state of Ohio. Within the following year, other counseling programs in Ohio followed and began CSI chapters. At the ETA chapter initiation ceremony in 1985, Dr. Tom Sweeney, Executive Director of CSI initiated the first 45 members of the chapter. Charter members of ETA Chapter included YSU faculty members Larry DiRusso, David Cliness, William Convery, Chris Faiver, Jan Gill-Wigal, George Levitsky, as well as, alumni, students, and counseling professionals from the Youngstown area.

The first elected officers were Sharon Forte as President, Dee Hall Edwards as Secretary, and Donald Nolfi as Treasurer. Nationally, the ETA CSI chapter was the 12th chapter initiated. Over 440 university based chapters have been established and over 162,000 counseling professionals and students have been initiated into Chi Sigma Iota since 1985. ETA Chapter has inducted over 1,000 members since 1985. Upon the inception of the ETA Chapter it was, recognized as the "most promising new campus organization". The Nova Award was presented to ETA Chapter at the YSU Annual Awards Banquet in 1986. The selection was made by students, faculty, and staff to recognize the campus organization that made the most significant progress during its first year of existence. In 1987, YSU was the site for the First Annual "All-State CSI Conference". The purpose of the conference was to provide members of CSI around the state with the opportunity to collaborate. In 1992, Jonathan Tobias served as the student editor of the first issue of The Ohio Student Journal for Counseling and Development. This journal was published by OCA and accepted papers from masters or doctoral level students.

Eta Chapter students have been recognized nationally for their excellence. In 2003, Brandy Kelly Gilea was selected by Chi Sigma Iota International as CSI Intern. In 2005, Rachel Hoffman--O'Neill was selected as a CSI Fellow. In 2008, ETA Chapter received three national awards, the Individual Program Award, the Outstanding Masters Student Award recognizing Karlyn Cunningham, and a Chapter Grant Award which was spearheaded by Amber Pratt. In 2010, Eta Chapter was recognized with the Outstanding Chapter Award, and Nicole Adamson was selected as a CSI Leadership Fellow. In 2011, Nicole Adamson was awarded the Outstanding Entry Level Student Award, and Emily Herman was selected as a CSI Leadership Fellow. Eta Chapter member and former Eta Chapter Advisor, Dr. Victoria Kress was elected as President of CSI-International for the 2012-13 year. In 2014, the Eta Chapter won the Outstanding Individual Program award for their statewide Leadership and Advocacy Summit at Youngstown State University. In 2015, Rebecca Szanto was awarded the Outstanding Entry Level Student Award, and Michael Leskosky was selected as a CSI Leadership Fellow. In 2018, Dr. Jake Protivnak received the Outstanding Faculty Advisor award from CSI. He was then elected as Treasurer of CSI-International for the 2019-2021 years. In 2020, Eta Chapter was awarded the Outstanding Individual Program Award.

The faculty continue to maintain the program's CACREP accreditation for all four program tracks (addiction counseling, clinical mental health counseling, school counseling, and college counseling and student affairs) receiving full reaccreditation in the summer of 2023. We will assist students in understanding the strengths, limitations, and pragmatic issues involved in utilizing

emerging practices. Finally, the counseling faculty will promote opportunities and advocate for social justice for urban and rural populations, while facilitating students' skills in assisting this population. Ultimately, we will explore ways to develop and support the next generation of counselors to be inclusive, resourceful, compassionate, and thoughtful here in the Mahoning Valley and throughout the world.
