YSU Summer Bridge Program 2018 Update

- The Summer Bridge 2018 program was awarded a \$5,000.00 grant by the Raymond John Wean Foundation.
- The Summer Bridge 2018 Program took place from Sunday, July 22 through Friday, July 27, 2018.
- There were a total of 35 students who participated in the 2018 Summer Bridge program which was a little lower than the 2017 cohort which had a total of 39 students but it was still the second highest total in the history of the program.
- The program collaborated with the community by featuring Guy Burney from Youngstown's Community Initiative. The Summer Bridge Program also worked with Youngstown City Schools, Mahoning Valley College Access Program, Eastern Ohio Education Partnership and Inspiring Minds.
- The Summer Bridge Program continues to show success with retaining students. As of August 7, the fall to fall retention rate for Summer Bridge 2017 is 77% which historically is a much higher fall-to-fall retention rate when compared to the overall minority first year fall-to-fall retention rate.

CURRENT ACCREDITATION ACTIVITY September 2018

Summary of recent site visits:

• The Committee on Accreditation for the Exercise Sciences (CoAES) recommended initial accreditation for the YSU undergraduate Exercise Science program to the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) on May 18, 2018, and CAAHEP granted its approval.

Summary of recent accreditation actions:

• On July 30, 2018, the Institutional Actions Council (IAC) of the Higher Learning Commission continued the accreditation of YSU with the next Reaffirmation of Accreditation scheduled to occur in 2027-28. In conjunction with this action, the IAC required the following interim monitoring: an interim report on credit hour policy (due 12/1/2018) and an interim report on program review (due 9/1/2021). The IAC concurred with the review team's findings and voted to affirm the institution's eligibility to select the Standard or Open Pathway for reaffirmation of accreditation. Update on Assessment of Student Learning

YSU has made and continues to make progress in fostering meaningful and relevant assessment of student learning:

• Integration of Assessment in Program Review: In response to concerns about the duplicative nature of reporting in assessment, program review, and annual reporting, the Office of Assessment (OOA) has been working with the Streamlining Academic Reporting Processes (SARP) Committee to incorporate assessment reporting into a larger institutional planning and reporting process. Over the last year, this SARP group has been working to "think big" in considering how to best align various reporting requirements as well as encourage greater use of these reports in institutional planning.

SARP is currently determining how to integrate and align efforts with the strategic planning and program optimization initiatives already underway. Integrating assessment, program review, and planning has been a long-term goal and was a recommendation from YSU's HLC mentor during participation in the HLC Academy (2008-2012).

- Co-curricular Assessment Reporting: The co-curricular assessment reporting cycle began in June 2018. Co-curricular units have begun reporting in the Taskstream Accountability Management System (AMS) this year; the new system allows stronger connections between data collection, analysis, and curricular and programmatic improvements to improve student learning. The feedback from departments so far has been positive. OOA intends to roll out the Taskstream system to academic departments in the 2018-19 academic year.
- Activities to Promote a Positive Assessment Culture: A central part of meeting HLC
 accreditation expectations is fostering a dynamic campus community with faculty and staff
 engaged in meaningful student learning assessment activities. In addition to fulfilling HLC
 expectations, these activities meet the goals of the 2020 Strategic Plan cornerstones in the
 areas of Accountability, Student Success, and Urban Research.

A critical part of building a positive culture is professional development to build capacity in assessment and increase the knowledge and skills of faculty and staff. In June 2018, the Office of Assessment funded a 13-member team of staff and faculty to attend the Student Affairs Assessment and Research Conference (SAARC) at Ohio State University. SAARC provides opportunity to integrate best practices in assessment, foster an evidence-based approach to improvement, and increase professional connections across campus and with other regional institutions. The Financial Aid office presented assessment findings at SAARC on educating YSU students in financial literacy issues.

• National Survey of Student Engagement and Faculty Survey of Student Engagement: The National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) was fielded in spring 2018. The NSSE collects data on first-year and senior student experiences in the areas of academic challenge, learning with peers, experiences with faculty, campus environment, and high impact experiences such as research or internships. The addition of a new question module,

Inclusiveness and Engagement with Cultural Diversity, will allow OOA to explore students' exposure to inclusive teaching practices and intercultural learning, perceptions of institutional values and commitment regarding diversity, and participation in diversity-related programming and coursework.

For the first time, OOA has fielded the Faculty Survey of Student Engagement (FSSE), a survey designed to complement the NSSE. The FSSE asks instructional staff about learning and development emphasis, student interactions, and how they spend their time in and out of the classroom.

Data from the NSSE and FSSE was released in August and will be shared with the campus community in fall 2018.

• The Noel Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI) and Adult Student Priorities Survey (ASPS): These two surveys were fielded to all YSU students in spring 2017, with a total response rate of 20%. In the SSI and ASPS, students are asked to provide feedback on what is most important to them as well as how satisfied they are with different aspects of campus life. This information provides valuable feedback on where the university is best meeting students' needs, as well as where there are opportunities for the university to improve students' experiences. Results of campus presentations, discussion sessions, and graduate student research projects were compiled in summer 2018, and final recommendations were shared with senior leadership in August.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS UPDATE SEPTEMBER 2018

1. Undergraduate Program Development:

<u>Undergraduate Program Actions Requiring Board of Trustees Action and/or Notification or Approval by the Ohio Department of Higher Education</u>

Since the last set of YSU Board of Trustees meetings, the Ohio Department of Higher Education has approved the following undergraduate program changes:

- The Associate of Applied Science in Drafting and Design Technology program has been deactivated due to low enrollment.
- The following programs have been deactivated due to low enrollment: Bachelor of Arts in American Studies, Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics, Bachelor of Arts in Africana Studies, Bachelor of Arts in Art History.
- The former Bachelor of Applied Science in Medical Laboratory Science is now named the Bachelor of Science in Medical Laboratory Science.

2. Graduate Program Development:

The Chancellor's Council on Graduate Studies (CCGS) and Graduate Council have approved an abbreviated new program review process for one year. A new proposal may now begin at the full proposal stage. The full proposal must be reviewed by the internal curriculum process and then go to the Board of Trustees for action and approval. The proposal then goes to CCGS for a second review and in-person presentation. If CCGS recommends the program for approval—and after YSU Board of Trustees approval—it goes to the Chancellor's staff, which makes a recommendation to the Chancellor based on CCGS review and public comments. The Chancellor's signature is the final step of the approval process. Board of Trustees approval is required prior to any final decision by the Chancellor's office.

- The full proposal for the **Ph.D.** in **Health Sciences** was approved by CCGS.
- The full proposal for the **Master of Science in Health Sciences** was approved by CCGS.
- The full proposal for the **Master of Science in Health Informatics** is being developed by campus committees.
- The Master of Science in Applied Behavior Analysis was approved for reactivation by CCGS.
