### **HUMAN RESOURCES UPDATE**

## Human Resources Reorganization:

In a collaboration with our IT department, the Manager of Training and Development will transfer to IT. The junior position to the Manager is vacant.

The functions of classification, compensation, and HR – management related training initiatives were consolidated under the newly created Director of Organizational Development. The junior position in Training and Development has been reclassified to an Organization and Development Officer position.

This strategic restructuring will better serve the university's ever increasing needs, create greater efficiency, and optimize our limited departmental resources.

The assessment of the department structure is on-going and may lead to other changes.

## Health Care and Benefit Management Initiative:

The vacant Benefits Manager position was filled on July 9, 2018. Goals for the new manager are in development. There is optimism that new leadership will move this important department forward.

HR took advantage of the transition to the flat 15% health care premium cost sharing structure to conduct a special, one-time open enrollment. This allowed those who cover a spouse on the YSU plan as a secondary dependent to delete them July 1, 2018 or to enroll themselves and dependents in a less costly alternative plan.

Leadership of the four unions were given an advance notice and responded to our invitation to inform their membership about the special open enrollment.

A Benefits Fair was conducted, bring in all medical and insurance vendor along with OPERS and STRS, and all of the retirement fund providers for direct vendor communication.

The University has joined other state universities in amending its EAP to allow for expert second options; research on diagnosis and treatment options; identifying regional specialists; facilitated appointments to centers of excellence and best match specialists; and gathering and coordinating medical records.

Health Care Advisory Committee (HCAC) Initiative:

HR led an initiative to amend the HCAC charter to reduce the meeting schedule from 10 to 6 calendar year meetings; accept a recommendation to allow for electronic voting; and for Human Resources to provide a summary of each meeting to all members and archive on the HR web site. Internal Efficiency Review:

HR has begun to review and improve its form letters, appointment letters, and use electronic distribution vs. paper.

Other initiatives will include documenting processes and operating procedures, which will be posted on the HR website.

## Fiduciary Duty Requirements:

In coordination with Legal Affairs, Finance & Business Affairs, and the IUC, HR is working to implement a significant compliance plan to meet the challenges of the growing number of lawsuits vs. colleges and universities being filed related to retirement plans and vendors. The University must meet and precisely document its duty of loyalty, prudence, and adherence to plan documents.
