### Super Dana

More than two dozen alumni, faculty, staff and student musicians from YSU's Dana School of Music provided the musical orchestration for the singing of *America the Beautiful* by Chloe and Halle, right, during Super Bowl pregame ceremonies in Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta on Feb. 3. "It is truly an honor to have Dana featured in such a prominent way on the world stage," said Phyllis Paul, dean of the YSU Cliffe College of Creative Arts and Communication.



### **Enrollment: Lucky seven**

YSU's enrollment "winning streak" continues as student numbers for Spring 2019 are again on the rise. Headcount enrollment of 11,900 is up 0.24 percent over last spring, while full-time equivalent enrollment is up 0.79 percent. It's the seventh straight semester (fall-to-fall and spring-to-spring) that FTE enrollment has gone up.



### **BUILD** up on Fifth

Fifth Avenue, from Mercy Health through the YSU campus, will undergo significant improvements as part of a \$10.8 million federal infrastructure grant announced by the U.S. Department of Transportation. The project, known as the SMART<sup>2</sup> Network, will completely renovate Fifth, Rayen and Park avenues and Federal, Front, Boardman and Commerce streets, including new street lighting, sidewalks, crosswalks, landscaping and medians.

### Wellness: Lucky eight

YSU's employee worksite wellness program has again received the Gold Level Award from the Healthy Business Council of Ohio. This is the eighth year that YSU has been recognized, and the fourth year with a Gold Award. YSU, which is in the "large business" category (more than 1,000 employees), is the only public university in the state to receive the gold honor.
