DEFINITIONS

NOTE: The campus based/online term and the high school-based term have different dates. Please refer to the proper column for that term.

High School Based Courses: Courses taught at the HS by a certified instructor employed by the high school. Any online courses offered to only CCP students follow the campus schedule.

First Day of Term: Date the term begins.

Last Day to Add: Last day to add a course to the students' schedule.

- The last day to add varies depending on what part-of-term the course is scheduled for. A term specific calendar is emailed to coordinators and students at the start of each term.
- Campus/online students add the course through their portal.
- High school-based courses require a change of registration form.

Last Day to Withdraw with No Charge: Also known as the 100% refund date of the term, this is the last day to drop a course from the student's schedule without being charged tuition.

• The 100% refund date varies depending on what part of term the

course is scheduled for. A term specific calendar is emailed to coordinators and students at the start of each term.

- Campus/online students drop the course through their portal. Books must be returned or the school will be charged.
- High school-based courses require a change of registration form. Last Day to Withdraw with a W: Students can withdraw from a

course and receive a W on their transcript.

- The last day to withdraw with a W varies depending on what part-of-term the course is scheduled for. A term specific calendar is emailed to coordinators and students at the start of each term.
- Campus/online students drop the course through their portal. Books must be returned or the school will be charged.
- High school-based courses require a change of registration form. The high school may seek reimbursement from the student for tuition and books paid on their behalf.

End of Term: Last day of the semester.
