





Health is more than your physical fitness. It encompasses every aspect of your life, from the physical to the mental and emotional. That's a high standard for some. But for us, it's our life's work.


We incorporate field and clinical experiences to give you the career advantages you need.
















Everyone loves a success story.

SOKOLOV HONORS COLLEGE AWARDS

MINIMUM CRITERIA

Students accepted for membership into the Sokolov Honors College may be considered for additional scholarships, including: Tuition scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$3,000 (renewable for four years) Housing scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$3,000 (renewable for Sokolov HONORS COLLEGE)

 24 credit hours per academic year

RENEWAL

 Minimum 12 hours per term

3.0 overall GPA

 Honors tuition scholarships are estimated between \$4,000 and \$12,000 over four years.

COMBINED VALUE

 Honors housing scholarships are estimated between \$2,000 and \$6,000 over two years.

Test-optional merit-based scholarships will be awarded to incoming freshman students admitted under YSU's test-optional admission policy.

Scholarships will range in value from \$1,000 to \$3,000 through the Freshman Scholarships for Excellence program. Additional \$1,000 to \$3,000 test-optional merit-based scholarships may be awarded to Honors College applicants who qualify for the Sokolov Honors College.
