

Now that you are admitted, follow these steps to finish your enrollment to YSU.

□ Advisement, Registration, and Transfer Student Orientation

Your next step is to set up an appointment with an academic advisor to schedule your courses. Feel free to call one of the academic advising offices in the college to which you are accepted. Please refer to your acceptance letter regarding what number below to call. (Please note: follow instructions on the back to see if your credits are posted prior to calling for an appointment).

Transfer students can either complete the Transfer Student Orientation (TSO) online or in person. **Please refer to your acceptance letter to see if TSO is required for you.** TSO is not required for all transfer students, but highly recommended.

- ◇ Conditionally admitted students must contact the Center for Student Progress to sign a contract.

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Instructions to Run a uAchieve Audit:

Please make sure you check to see if your courses are posted to your record prior to making your advising appointment (detailed steps on the front).

- ◇ Log into MyYSU Portal
- ◇ In the e-services for Students area; select “uAchieve”
- ◇ Select “Run Declared Programs”
- ◇ Please note: it may take several seconds for the audit to load
- ◇ Under the View column, click on “View Audit”
- ◇ Use the scroll bar on the right to scroll through the audit or click on the printer icon to print

Student can also run a “what-if” audit to see how their credits apply to different majors. Please follow the below instructions to run a “what-if” audit

- ◇ Follow the first 2 steps above
- ◇ Click on “Select a Different Program”
- ◇ Using the “Program” drop down list, choose a degree
- ◇ Click on “Run Different Program”
- ◇ Please note: it may take several seconds for the audit to load
- ◇ Use the scroll bar on the right to scroll through the audit or click on the printer icon to print

Please note: Some advisors will not meet with students until the transfer credits are posted. Please allow a few weeks after you are accepted to YSU for the credits to be posted to your file. If you have any questions, feel free to contact Office of Admissions.

Transferology

Transferology is a free online tool that lets you enter your previous institution’s courses to see how they match to YSU courses. This can help you determine the transferability and applicability of your credits. You can use several of the resources on Transferology including
