

OCTOBER 18, 2018 HCAC MEETING SUMMARY

Dave Barchet from Findley presented an update on the renewal of vision care benefits through National Vision Administrators, including the how rates for each subscriber group. He explained that the cost increase was within market norms and that YSU is free to pursue cost saving opportunities through the IUC aggregation project. Barchet then opened the floor to any questions about the renewal or IUC initiatives from committee members.

Stephanie Muller from MMO presented a summary of an Employer Profile Report. The report focused on the following.

Exhibits for each category were presented, with ample opportunities for questions from the committee members.

Don Kline and his executive team from Mercy Health provided a comprehensive update on the progress of its narrow network health care insurance program. Following the presentation, some committee members had questions about the narrow network as a potential alternative plan. It was agreed that the HR staff from YSU, and our partners from Findley and MMO would provide additional information about how the narrow network is structured from the user/patient perspective.
