What is ProjectBoard? ProjectBoard is a virtual space to share projects and solve problems. It is a place for students to document and showcase their work and provides an easy way for students to share their project with their teachers and their mentors. It has been used for virtual science fairs and for project-based learning by schools and universities.

ProjectBoard is replacing STEM WIZARD. Not only does it serve as the site for teachers and students to register for district science day it is a great tool for project development. Though it is not required for participation in local science fairs students are strongly encouraged to use it at the beginning of their project.

Registration through ProjectBoard is required for district science day. The registration deadline for all districts is Monday, February 27. There is no requirement that a student earn a superior rating at a local fair to participate in district science day. Any student with a completed and approved project may register.

A number of resources are available for you to learn more about ProjectBoard.
