

# STUDENT CONDUCT PROCESS AT YSU



INCIDENT OCCURS

Reported by member of campus

Reviewed for violations of *Student Code of Conduct*

Case *does not* include potential violations

Receive an e-mail from the Office of Community Standards & Student Conduct for a meeting

Case does not qualify as a violation or is low-level and student has no prior conduct history

Case closed and/or potential coaching meeting with staff

Attend Conduct Conference to discuss incident

Do you accept responsibility and were you informed that the violation **does not** require a hearing?

Sanctions assigned with deadline dates - case is closed when sanctions are completed and accepted

Formal Student Conduct Board Hearing scheduled

Were you found responsible for charges?
