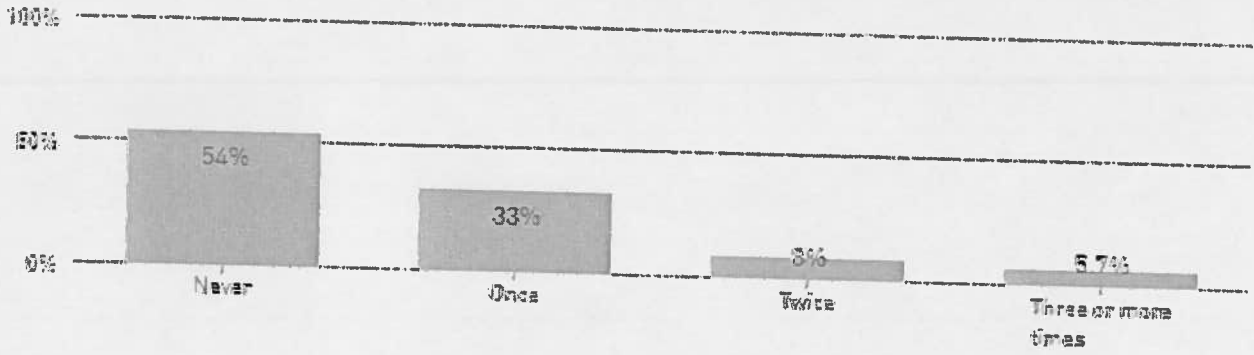

During the past two weeks, how many times have you had five or more drinks in a row within a 2 hour period?



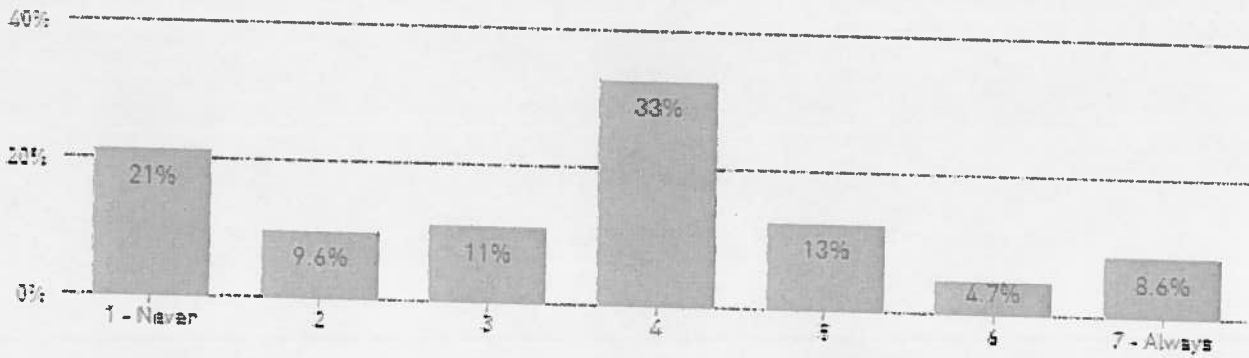
When You Drink

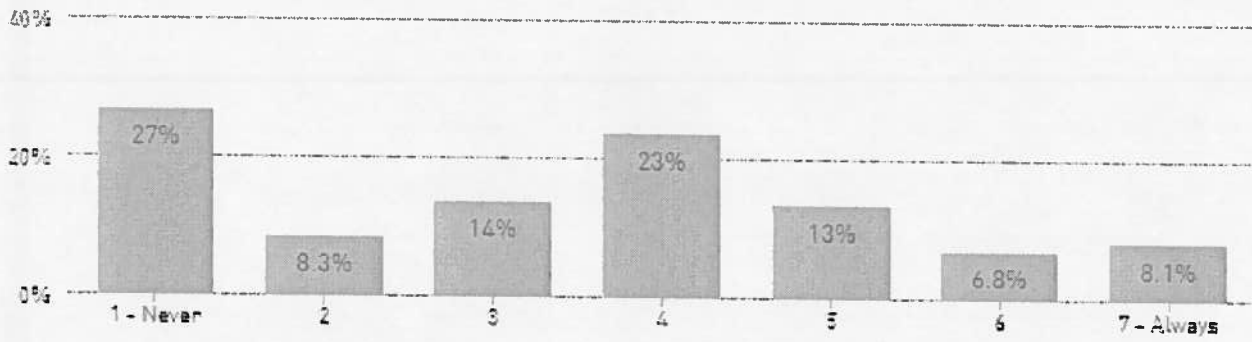

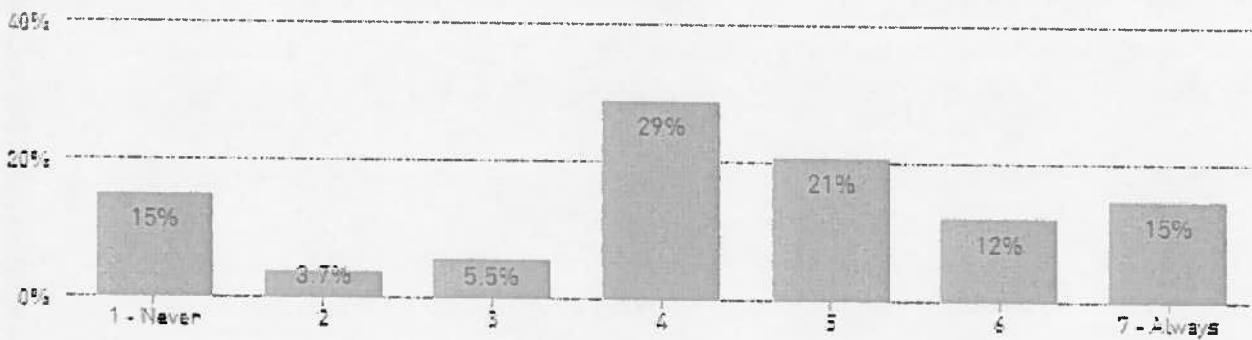

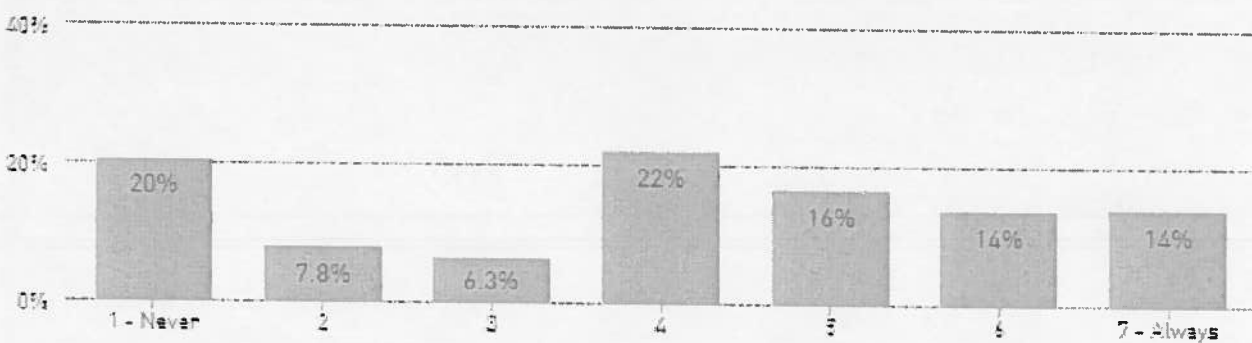

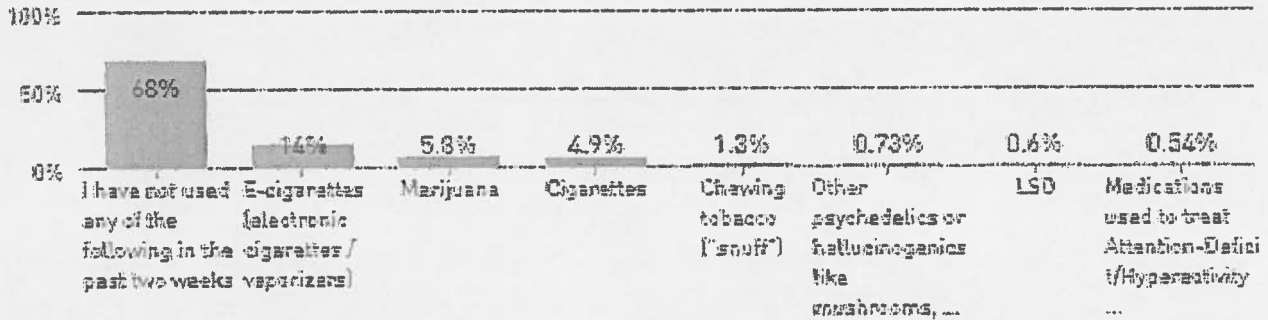

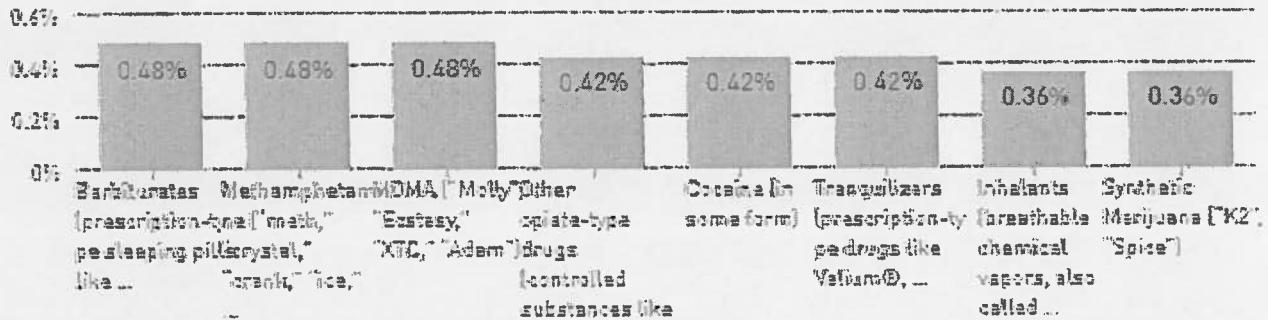

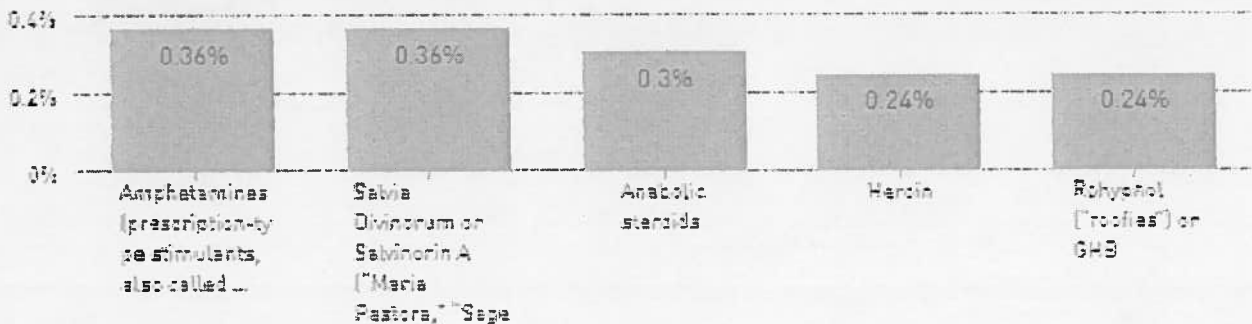

Next 8 most common responses



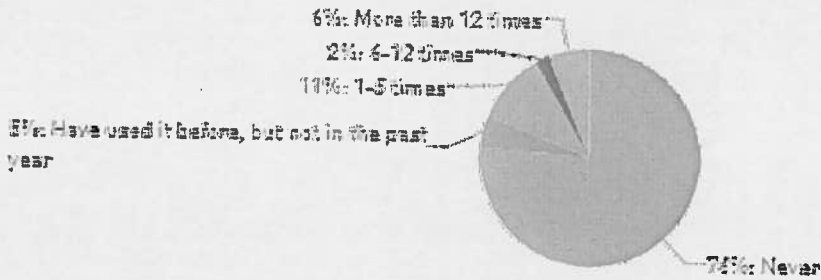

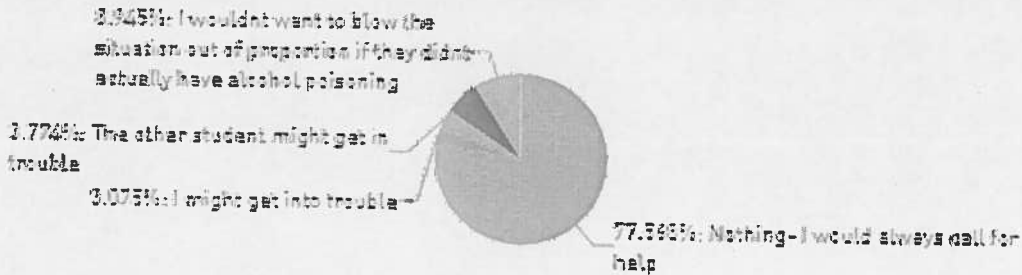

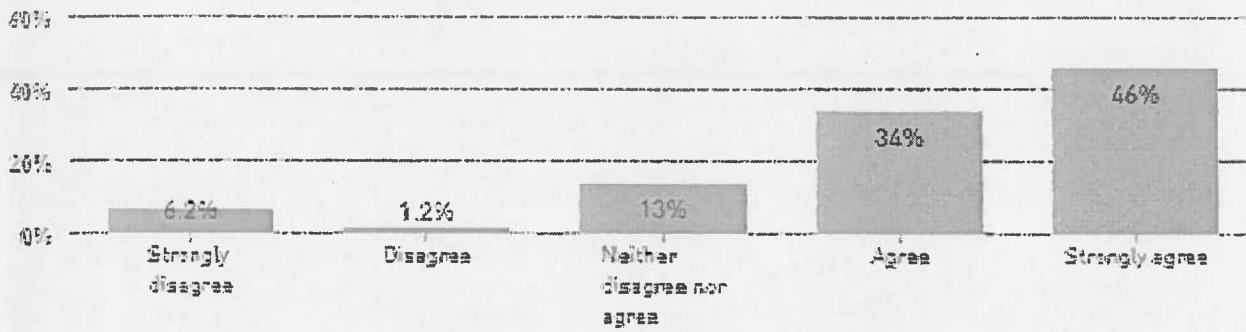
How often have you used marijuana in the past year?



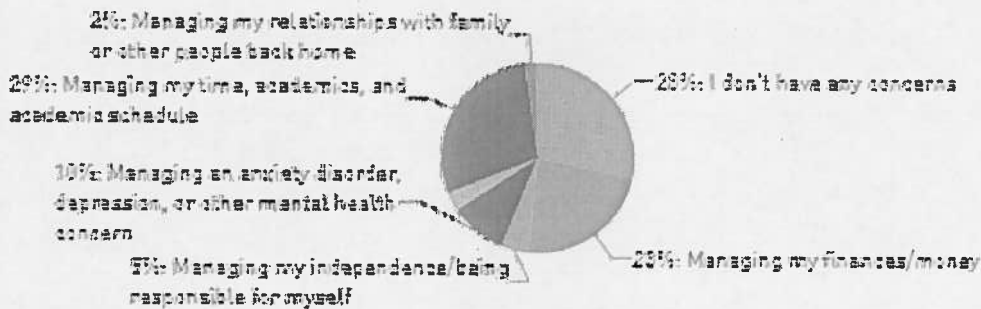
If you were concerned that another student might be suffering from alcohol poisoning, which of the following would be the biggest reason you might NOT call for help (police, 911, EMT, RA)?



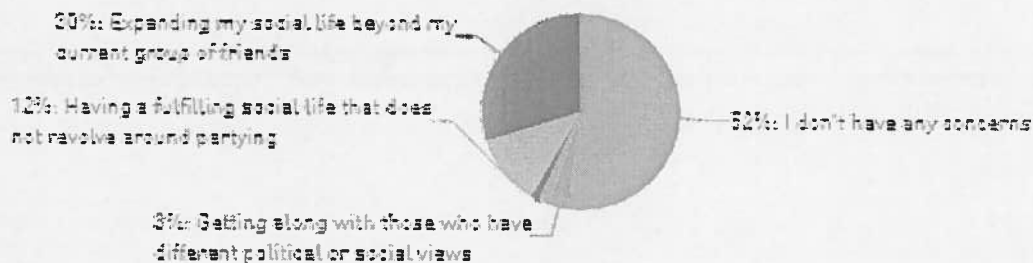
If I had too much to drink I would want someone to intervene.



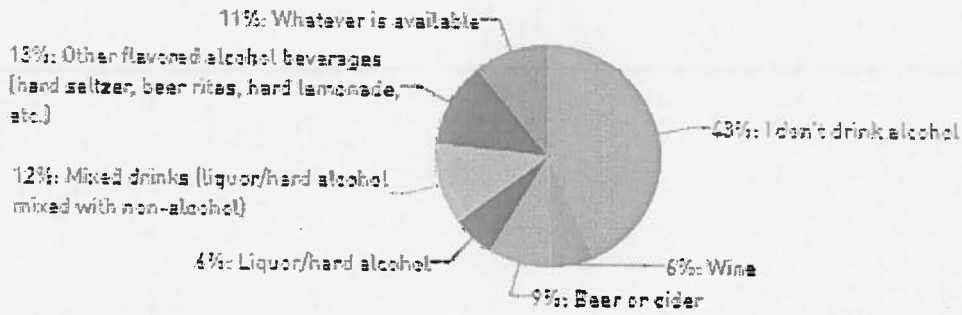
Considering the following list of general college transition issues that students often face, which one are you most concerned about?



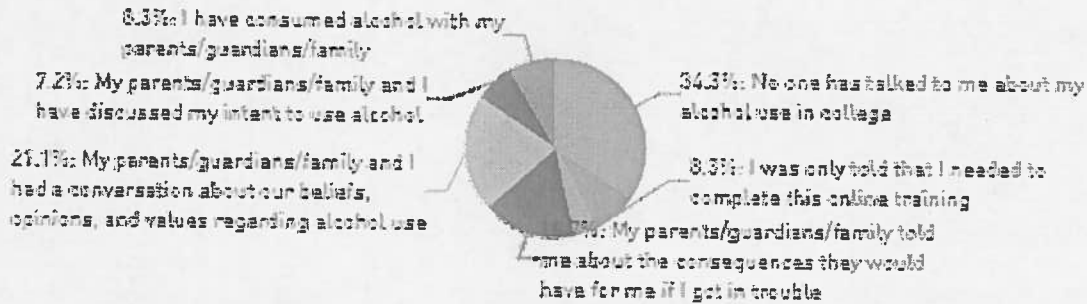
Considering the following list of college social transition issues that students often face, which one are you most concerned about?



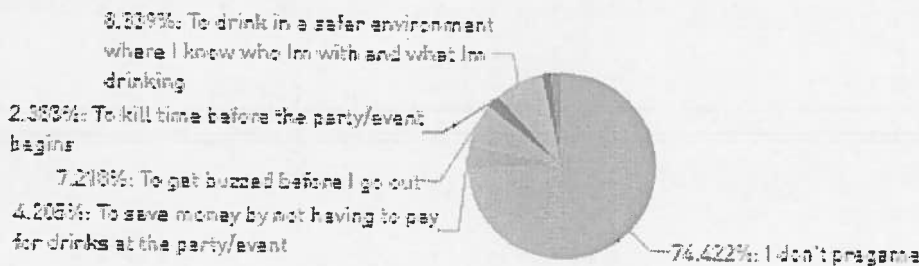
If/when you choose to drink alcohol, what kind of alcohol do you drink?



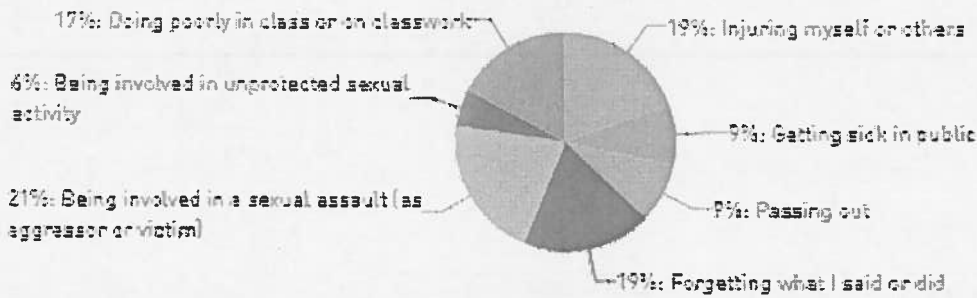
Which of the following best describes conversations that you have had with your parents, guardians, or other family members regarding your alcohol use in college?



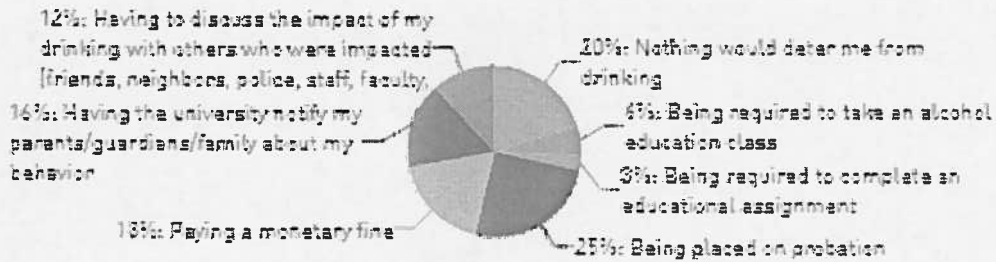
When you choose to pregame (drinking before you go out to a party/event) what is your primary reason for doing so?



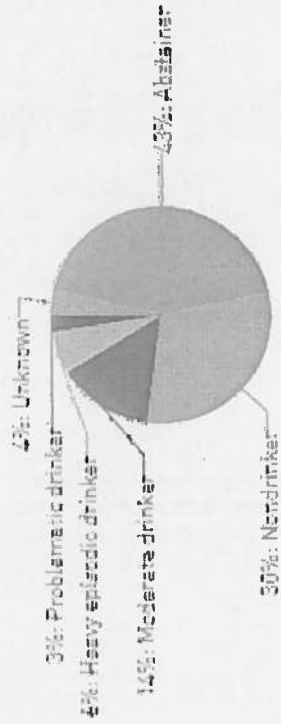
What alcohol related behaviors or consequences concern you most?

Drinker Categories Survey 3



Definitions

Each student belongs to exactly one drinker category. Drinker category is determined by the number of standard drinks students had on the day of their highest alcohol consumption in the past two weeks. Because, on average, the same amount of alcohol affects males and females differently, drinker category is also influenced by biological sex. For example, a male who consumed 4 drinks on a single day would be classified as a “moderate drinker,” while a female consuming the same amount would be a “heavy episodic drinker.”

Abstainer

Consumed no alcohol in the past year.

Nondrinker

Consumed no alcohol in the past two weeks, but may have consumed in the past year.

Moderate drinker

On the day of highest alcohol use in the past two weeks, the student had 1-4 drinks (male) or 1-3 drinks (female).

Heavy episodic drinker

On the day of highest alcohol use in the past two weeks, the student had 5-9 drinks (male) or 4-7 drinks (female).

Problematic drinker

On the day of highest alcohol use in the past two weeks, the student had 10+ drinks (male) or 8+ drinks (female).

Unknown

Did not provide enough information to determine drinker category.
