## DO I NEED A FOREIGN LANGUAGE FOR MY BACHELOR'S DEGREE

All candidates for the Bachelor of Arts degree are required to demonstrate proficiency at the 2600 level in any foreign language. Students with a foreign language background may desire to take the foreign language placement test in order to place into the second semester (2600) or beyond (which will satisfy the foreign language requirement).
