Time-frame/Framework (Connecting Top to Bottom: Connecting Bottom to Top)

- The attached timeframe was discussed as a framework for the planning process this coming academic year
- It was emphasized that we desire to assure all constituencies are well connected to the process
 - Each member of SPOT is a connector to a respective constituency
 - A component of the process will be to secure constituency input through activities instigated by the connector with that constituency
- It was emphasized that the intent is to provide an overarching planning framework (top) with an academic program/college-focused deliberation (bottom)
 - Overarching framework (top) will be created via thought-provoking conversations on campus perhaps stimulated by outside speakers or internal discussion agendas
 - The academic program/college-focused framework (bottom) will be created in collaboration with deans/chairs/directors for discussions regarding points of pride; foundational qualities; compelling attributes of distinction; strategies focused on student success; interdisciplinary initiatives/opportunities
- The planning process should result in a Plan that is "tethered" to reality
 - \circ $\;$ This could occur via a situational analysis completed by each VP/AVP $\;$

Discuss the connectors/case study document

- It was emphasized that the case study document is an evolutionary document that is added to over time given the attributes of the planning process
- Each constituent-connector this summer will develop a narrative describing:
 - The involvement by the constituent group in the previous plan;
 - \circ $\;$ The involvement by the constituent group in the upcoming planning process; and
 - How to best engage the constituency in conversations regarding YSU in the context of the evolving higher education landscape of the future
- Should aspects of the case study be developed by VP/AVPs?
