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# Section II: Description of the proposal and its alignment with the YSU 2020 Strategic Plan

Please summarize the proposal and specify how it aligns with the YSU 2020 Strategic Plan. The YSU Department of Nursing, one of the university's highly valued majors on campus, enrolls over 400 students in its restricted programs: Entry-level BSN, RN-BSN Online Completion, MSN programs consisting of five options (acute care nurse practitioner, family nurse practitioner, nurse anesthesia and nursing education) and Post-graduate advance practice registered nurse certificate programs. The Department of Nursing is requesting funding for a new pediatric simulator manikin (SimJunior®) to be used by nursing students across the curriculum to promote knowledge, increased critical thinking and clinical judgment. Simulation is a teaching-learning strategy frequently utilized in nursing and other health care programs, providing students with kinesthetic skills development, hands-on care and life-like responses to unexpected circumstances. A specific disease-based scenario is programmed to the simulator manikin offering practice in the simulation lab prior to the student caring for live patients in health care settings. Example scenarios include asthma, stroke, sickle cell disease, seizures and cardiac arrest. Currently, the Department of Nursing has an updated adult and OB simulator but is in need of a pediatric simulator to provide learning in undergraduate pediatrics and graduate family nurse practitioner and nurse anesthesia. The Youngstown State University Department of Nursing enrolls over 100 entry-level BSN students per year. More importantly, the program typically retains and graduates over 80% of the enrolled students. There is also robust recruitment in the RN-BSN online completion and the MSN options equaling over 150 students. The nursing simulation lab is always a popular stop on CRASH or other recruitment days. Without the availability of the simulation technology, potential students would select other nursing schools. The scenario simulation strategy is also encouraged and promoted as an effective learning strategy by the Ohio Board of Nursing, our regulatory agency and Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE), our national accrediting agency. A new SimJunior Manikin from Laerdal has the potential to allow community nurses to complete educational requirements as mandated by the Joint Commission, a hospital and health care accrediting agency. Frequently, specific scenarios are required for reaccreditation. Often, hospitals choose not to purchase the simulator but seek schools who own the manikins for a fee. The investment of the simulation technology is worth the cost.

At this point, there is not a need additional staffing related to the purchase of SimJunior. Currently a designated nursing faculty has responsibilities as the simulation coordinator and our learning resource coordinator provides additional assistance.  In the future however, as enrollment and programming grow in the Department of Nursing, there will be a need for a designated full-time Nursing Simulation Coordinator.

There are no risks identified by the purchase of a SimJunior simulation manikin.

To avoid risk in the clinical setting, it is important in the field of nursing to have students apply their classroom learning in a laboratory setting before they are one on one with living patients. By learning to perform tasks correctly in the lab and with the appropriate technology such as simulation, the risk of making an error in the real clinical setting is significantly decreased. Students will be prepared for situations that they might not expect.

Additional benefits to avoid potential errors in the clinical setting include, allowing students to request scenarios that they might not get to experience in a clinical setting. The ability to practice during a stress free learning experience can help save real lives in stressful clinical settings, and in the health care field after graduation.
